Skills intelligence:

Analyse skills gaps and formulate measures to address them

→ National platforms & roadmaps

Skills uptake:

Measures increasing the demand for skills and skilled professionals

→ campaigns, onestop-shops, procurement



Skills development:

Develop new or upgrade existing qualification & training schemes addressing emerging skills

Key figures:

- Launched in 2011 and supported via:
 - ✓ Intelligent Energy Europe
 - ✓ Horizon 2020
 - ✓ LIFE Clean Energy transition
- 103 projects funded as of 2025 (+ 4 in grant preparation)
- **Nearly € 70 million EU funding since** 2011
- **National platforms and roadmaps** developped in 30 countries, recently updated in 15 Member States
- **50 000 professionals** taking part in pilot training sessions
- 16 EU exchange meetings among project teams

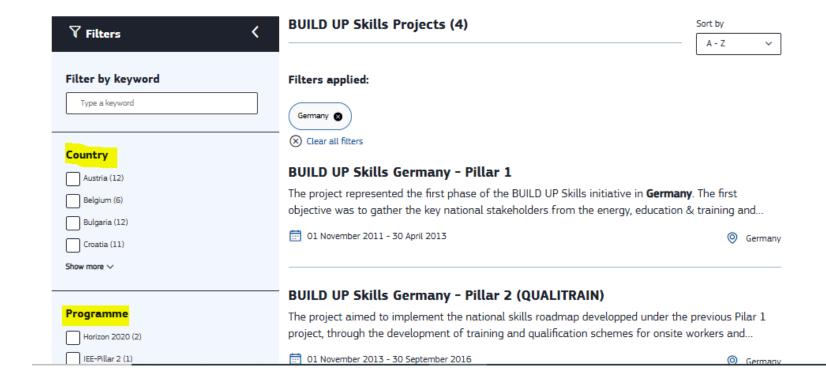

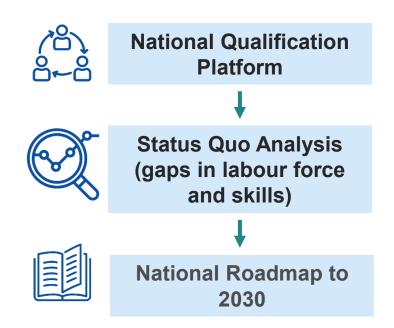






National Skills Roadmaps

- ✓ First exercise carried out in 2012-2013: 30 countries
- ✓ Update finalised in 2024 for 15 Member States
- ✓ Focus: skills related to the built environment (new constructions & renovations)

National Qualification Platforms

- Gathering key national stakeholder organisations, e.g.
 - education & training providers (universities, VET providers)
 - companies and professional organisations/chambers from the construction and renovation value chains
 - public authorities, energy agencies,
 - trade unions etc.

Close to 6000 organisations consulted

Status Quo Analysis

- National policies and strategies to contribute to the EU 2030 energy targets in buildings
- Key data on the building and energy sectors
- Existing provisions in the field of Education and Training
- Relevant EU and national projects
- Barriers to the uptake of training
- Gap analysis (quantitative & qualitative):
 - 1) Labour force evolution
 - 2) Skills needs
 - 3) Qualification needs
 - 4) Monitoring mechanisms



- Energy efficiency and renewable energy measures in buildings
- Deep renovation, including through modular and industrialised solutions
- Nearly Zero Energy Buildings → Zero Emission Buildings
- RES heating and cooling technologies, in particular heat pumps roll-out
- Whole life carbon (GWP), circular construction and resource efficiency, Level(s) framework
- Digital skills, e.g. Building Information Modelling
- Smart buildings (sensors, building controls and building management systems), Smart Readiness Indicator

National roadmaps

- On the basis of the Status Quo Analysis, project teams drafted the **National Roadmap** of measures to adress the identified labour force and skills gaps, in a 2030 perspective.
- Detailed set of measures + Action Plan: timeline, resources, funding mechanism, responsible organization, monitoring.
- Endorsement of the roadmap and the action plan by key national stakeholders.

National roadmaps



Examples of measures:

- ✓ Implement structural improvements to the (vocational) education sector: e.g. inclusion of new topics in curricula; improve teachers/trainers skills; update educational standards
- ✓ Develop new occupational standards: e.g. BIM manager, Building scanning expert, Thermal bridge assessment specialist (Romania)
- ✓ Roll out national awareness campaigns to attract more workers to the construction & renovation sectors
- ✓ Increase attractivity of the construction & renovation sectors, including for women and the youth
- ✓ Foster reskilling of workers from other sectors
- ✓ Leverage green public procurement to incentivise involvement of skilled workers.
