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- 1 Federal government
- 9 regional governments
- implementation of EED in Federal Energy Efficiency Law
- in force since August 2014
- full implementation notified to EC



Combined System

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Combined System

- 1. Energy Efficiency Obligation System
- 2. alternative Approach Art 7 (9)

Government program 2013-2018

- uniform legislation on national level
- continuation and optimization of existing programs
- mandatory industry commitments
- for all energy sources
- 40% of measures effective among households






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• Target 218 PJ cum 2014 -2020 Art 7 (1)

- transport excluded
- 25% from early actions
- national more ambitious 310 PJ
 - 159 PJ energy obligation system
 - 151 PJ strategic measures

Details Obligation System





- Energy suppliers, sold 25 GWh or more final energy last year to consumers for energy use alone or throughout the group
- Suppliers with higher shares than 50% are considered as one company
- proving energy efficiency measures in the amount of 0,6% of the final energy sold to consumers last year
- min. 40% of measures beomes effective among customers
- document measures and report to monitoring body till 14.2. next year

Details Obligation System

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3 possibilities to comply

- provide measures on their own
- award measures/savings to third parties
- pay a compensation 20 Eurocent/kWh n

Branch obligation

- small distributers ≥ 25 GWh and < 150 GWh join a branch obligation, fulfilling together the obligation
- agreement with ministry
- if not reached two following years \Rightarrow individual obligation



Details Obligation System

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- 1. banking allowed but no borrowing
- Big subsidy programmes from federal or local government not eligible for energy suppliers (avoid double counting)
- 3. Measures from energy suppliers or companies can be transferred to other stakeholders but only 4 times and within one year
- 4. savings from measures dying before 2020 are reduced respectively



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- 1. support for companies to improve environmental performance
- 2. Renovation initiative renovation vouchers
- 3. subsidies for refurbishment of buildings and energy efficient new buildings
- 4. Climate and Energy Fund
- 5. Measures under the General Transport Plan
- 6. Tax measures
- 7. Energy Advice and Energy Audits
- 8. Public Sector savings

Monitoring

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- independent monitoring body
- tendering procedure ongoing
- online data base
 - collecting measures Art. 7
 - from obliged parties as well as federal and local stakeholders
- reporting
- communication with stakeholders
- Support for federal and local governments
