Support to Energy Efficiency Development in Businesses (Technical assistance)

EED transposition (Legislative Decree 102/2014 and SAs)

- National Plan for Awareness Raise in SMEs (PS-PMI)
 - WHY: LD 102/2014, art. 8(10-ter)
 - WHO: Non-energy intensive SMEs (not art. 8 EED obligated)
 - WHAT: Support SMEs to adopt energy audits and EE interventions
- National Information and Training Campaign (PIF) ITALIA INCLASSE
 - WHY: LD 102/2014, art. 13
 - WHO: All (art. 8 EED obligated and not)
 - WHAT: Support companies to develop energy audits and use EE incentives
- Monitoring of additional savings from art. 8 obligated parties (based on <u>ENEA energy audit database</u>)
 - LD 102/2014, art. 7(8), useful info to assess existing EE incentives

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Alignment to the EE1st

(1) Quantify EE gains beyond the perimeter of the obligation

(2) Exploit the untapped energy efficiency potential in the productive sectors

(3) Shade lights on:

- Awareness on multiple benefits from EE
- Drivers and barriers to EE deployment


