Enova and The Energy Fund

- Enova is a State Enterprise owned by MPE
- Goal: "Enova promotes environmentally friendly restructuring of energy end-use and energy and climate production, and contributes to development of energy technology."
- Established in 2001
- The Energy fund is financed by a levy on the electricity grid tariff and through allocations from the state budget.
- Approximately 1800 MNOK (\$300 million) added annually.

Enova's measures aimed at small energy consumers

- Support scheme for private households
- Support scheme for SMEs
- Support scheme for building owners
- Advisory and information work

Households

Investment support in household sector for:

- energy advisement
- renovation
- phasing out oil boiler
- conversion from electric heating to renewable water heating.
- solar collector system and central heating management system

Buildings

- Investment support for new/renovated residential, commercial, and public buildings.
- Support from Enova dependent on going beyond minimum building regulations.

Investment Support for:

- Passive House Feasibility Studies
- Passive Houses and Low Energy Buildings
- Existing Buildings and Outdoor Facilities
- Local heating plant

SMEs

- The program is aimed at measures to reduce energy consumption and/or conversion to renewable energy carriers in the Norwegian mainland industry.
- Investment support in industry for:
 - energy management
 - implementing of energy measures

Advisory and information work

- "Ask Enova" (the information helpline)
- "Enova Recommends" (recommended products)
- "Enova Rainmakers" (energy awareness program for children)
- Courses and training
