





INDUCE – Experiences



Experience in Energy Measures implementation

- The need for data collection on the measures implemented was a requirement of the Project with the pilot companies.
- ✓ Privacy agreements with companies to acquire the data, and show it in an anonymised way.
- ✓ It was not possible to show individual data per company, but aggregated data for all companies, showing the final average values as the impact of the project.
- ✓ Important to know the energy efficiency needs and expectations of the company.
- ✓ All energy audits carried out during the project were very positively received.
- ✓ Initial considerations between SMEs and non-SMEs

INDUC

✓ Different situations between the EU-Member States involved in the project.





Through the INDUCE project, we worked on generating a need in the company about the energy field and its benefits, rather than on the actual action of an energy audit, which in many cases generates information, but in other cases does not bring added value to the company. This was done by accompanying them for almost 3 years, training them and, above all, speaking their own language. **INDUCE community with 60 trainers in Energy Efficiency and** the Human Centered Design Approach.
