Deontological Code for energy auditors in Romania

- Framework: Regulatory for the authorization of energy auditors for industry approved by ANRE Decision no.2794/2014, ammended by ANRE Decision no.1111/2017
- Validity conditions for the authorization of a physical energy auditor :
“The holder of the authorization is bound to comply with the Deontological Code of the authorized energy auditor as set out in the Regulation for the Authorization of Energy Auditors in Industry.”
- Effects in case on non compliance : suspension or withdrawal of authorization



Deontological Code for energy auditors in Romania

Background:

Request (for energy auditor authorization)

Checking eligibility conditions (authorization committee)

Authorization (validity conditions of the authorization)

Public list (Register of Energy Auditors)

Complaint

Analyse (authorization committee)

In case of non compliance: suspension of the authorisation

Appeal (authorization committee)

Withdrawal - If one of the situations that led to the suspension of the authorization persists



Deontological Code for energy auditors in Romania

Deontological Code of energy auditor = a set of rules that states the position and the quality of energy auditor`s professional activity

The energy auditor should :

- Acts professionally, without discrimination.
- Acts in the sense of increasing its own competence and assists those under its subordination to develop its relational skills in the activity of performing energy audits
- Does not act as a representative of some energy equipment manufacturers.



Deontological Code for energy auditors in Romania

- Maintains the confidentiality of the data obtained or resulting from the energy audit, unless it is required to make them known under the law, or obtain the written consent of the beneficiary of the energy audit in this respect.
- Does not communicate wrong information that compromises the energy audit activity or the authorization process.
- Does not prejudice the reputation of the licensing body through its activities.

Deontological Code for energy auditors in Romania

Other tool used by ANRE to evaluate the quality of energy audit:

- Forms for assessing the **quality of energy audits**

The template includes indicators as :

- compliance of the minimum criteria for elaboration of energy audit,
- relevance of the recommended energy efficiency measures for the beneficiary's activity,
- calculation of energy efficiency indicators,
- the proportionality of the cost related to the type of audit,
- representativeness related to energy consumption.

The score awarded after this assessment is taken into account to obtain the next certification of energy auditor.
